RULES:

TAKE-OFF & TRAILERING: ALT events will be an "On Your Hole" start. Teams will be required to check in at the launch site for boat check prior to launching. Trailing may be permitted based on weather conditions and will be announced by the tournament director by 8pm the night before the event.

PARTICIPATION & ELIGIBILTY: ALT events are open to all anglers. All anglers must have a valid fishing license. During tournament hours, every boat must have Boat Liability Insurance with effective dates for the tournament date. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.

TRAIL & ENTRY FEES: Trail fees will be \$50 per team and will be good for the entire series. Trail fees are used to cover trail expenses. Entry Fees are \$75 per team including big bass and will be paid the morning of the event with CASH only or by Wednesday the week prior to the event via Venmo @ c bearden36. An optional \$25 side pot will be available for each event.

CHAMPIONSHIP QULAIFICATION AND ENTRY: Teams must fish or pay the entry for 4 of the 5 events to qualify to the fish the Championship. If a team is going to pay for an event and not fish the entry must be paid prior to the event as this will be included in the payout for that event. The entry fee for the Championship is \$150 per team which will include big bass per day and overall payouts. An optional \$25 side pot will be available for each day of the championship.

OFF LIMITS & PRE-FISHING: There is a strict off-limits period for all ALT events. Off limits will begin at 12:00am on the Monday prior to the event and continue through take off on the day of the event (ALL WEEK). Any team that enters event waters will be disqualified for the event with no refund.

WEIGH IN & BAG LIMITS: Weights will be documents in decimal pounds to the nearest one hundredth of a pound. The limit is (5) bass per day. At no time shall a team have more than six (6) bass in the live well. Culling is allowed. State law does not allow culling of a dead fish. Only bass 14" or larger will be allowed. There will be a .50-pound penalty for each dead fish presented at weigh in. No dead fish can be weighed for big bass. Any short fish presented at weigh in will result in the loss of the fish and a 1-pound penalty. In the case of a tie, the tied teams will split the winnings based on the payout.

TEAMS: Team will consist of a 2-person team, however, either member may fish alone to represent the team, if one team member is unable to fish an event. A team that pays the trail fee must fish together for the entire series or enter as a new team.

PAYOUTS: One (1) place will be paid for every five (5) teams entered based on entries. One (1) place will be paid for the side pot. Prizes will be based on total entries. Big Bass will pay \$200 for first and a \$50 gift card to Baits n Blades for second regardless of entries.
